The Dutch mezzosoprano **Rosina Fabius** graduated in 2013 from the Utrechts Conservatory in the Netherlands and currently continues her studies in the Master of Music. This year she is studying as an Erasmus student under Prof. Claudia Visca and Prof. Gabriele Fontana at the Universität für Musik und Darstellende Kunst Wien (MDW).

Rosina has gained experience on the operatic stage though productions by Studio 32 Utrecht, performing a.o. the role of Marcellina from Mozart's Le Nozze di Figaro. In 2014 she performed the roles of La Messagiera and La Speranza in Monteverdi's Orfeo with Holland Opera. She is frequently asked to perform works by Bach and has performed as a soloist in the St. Matthew Passion and St. John's Passion several times in the Netherlands and abroad. Rosina enjoys performing in chamber music concerts as a member of the ARTO ensemble and the Fabius Ensemble, as well as giving song recitals. In the summer of 2014 she followed several intensive Masterclasses and coachings at the Franz Schubert Institut in Baden bei Wien, where she worked on German Lied repertoire together with her pianist Kanako Inoue. Amongst the many Masterclass teachers were Helmut Deutsch, Robertus Holl, Julius Drake and Christa Ludwig.
